It includes many of the comforts of a desktop PC including: floppy disk drive, workstation quality video and a comfortable keyboard with generous sized keys. It has a 15” display which is great for group presentations because it can be seen with equal ease from almost any angle and features video performance that more than equals that of the average desktop workstation. Plus, it is engineered to meet the graphically intensive needs of government agencies requiring a notebook computer with performance, rock-solid reliability and security compliance.

The DWT-302 utilizes Intel's new Centrino Duo Mobile technology for maximum performance with minimum battery drain and is available with an Intel® Core™ Duo Processor T2500, 2MB L2 cache, 2.0GHz Processor Speed and 667MHz FSB. This machine comes standard with 512MB SDRAM (with optional expandability to 4GB), a 80GB shock-mounted Hard Disk drive and a 15” 1600 x 1200 (XGA) TFT Active Matrix Color LCD. Two execution cores enable multiple applications to run simultaneously. Power is transferred only to those areas of the processor that need it.
